Charitable Donations Policy

It has been the custom and practice of Maugersbury Parish Council to establish an annual Income and Expenditure budget, which is sufficient for just essential activity. The rationale for this approach is to keep the Parish Council precept at a low level.

From time to time, Maugersbury Parish Council has been asked to make charitable donations but it has been and will continue to be Maugersbury Parish Council's policy to decline such requests.

As a result money collected from residents by way of the precept for essential Parish Council activity will not to be diverted to charitable donations.

N.B. This policy does not apply to donations for goods or services (for example defibrillator training), nor to the contribution made by Maugersbury Parish Council to the Stow Burial Board in respect of cemetery maintenance.
